- I. A. School Board Clerk Tim Fameree called the special meeting of the Board of Canvassers to order at 4:00 PM at the Luxemburg-Casco School District Office to canvass the November Election referendum votes. The November Election was held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010. Members that were present were Terri Veeseer and Fran Charles.
- B. This meeting notice was duly published in the Green Bay Press Gazette on Thursday, October 28, 2010. The meeting notice was faxed on Tuesday, October 26, 2010 for posting to: M&I Bank in Casco, Bank of Luxemburg (home office), Luxemburg Post Office, Casco Post Office, New Franken Post Office, Baylake Bank in Luxemburg and Harbor Credit Union in Luxemburg.
- C. School Board Clerk Tim Fameree selected Terri Veeseer and Fran Charles as canvassers consistent with Wi St. 7.53(1)(2)(3), 7.60(2).

Question 1: Should the school district borrow up to \$2,760,000 for building maintenance, including upgrading HVAC systems at the intermediate and middle schools, replacing windows and installing walls at the intermediate school, and installing a fire alarm system at the middle school?

**YES: 2,316**  
**NO: 2,177**

- Question 2: Should the school district borrow up to \$5,905,000 to build and equip a gymnasium addition at the high school and replace the soccer field and make other site improvements?

**YES: 1,651**  
**NO: 2,803**
